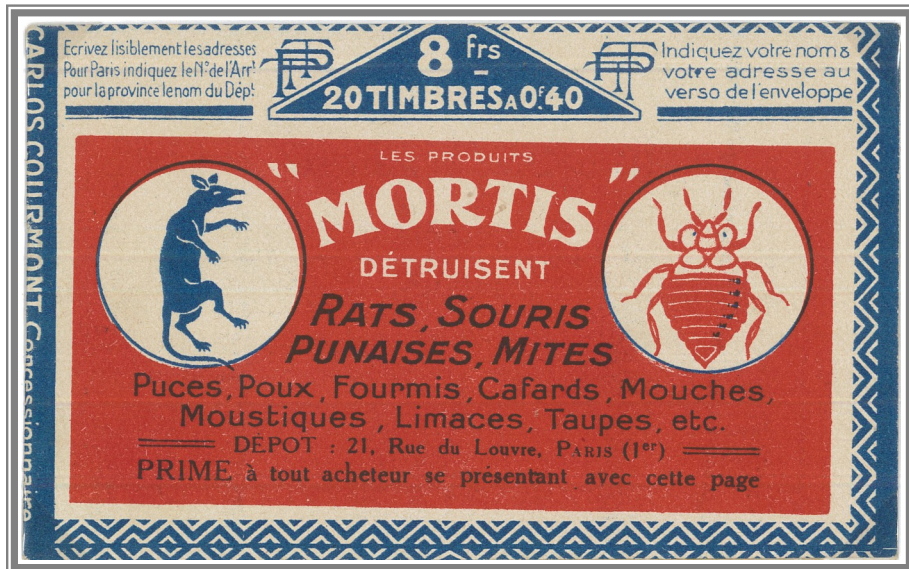


LEONARDO'S VIEW OF A TOWN: PACKED LIKE GOATS

Overcrowded Milan was struck by the plague. I devised a canal system that would bring fresh water to the city, fed by the river.



The problem is the dirt. People throw their litter out of the windows into the water on the streets. The mud rots there where it falls.



Sept. 9, 1836 Italy: Postage free stamp of the Apostolic Provincial Health Commission Ascoli to the Prior President of the health delegation in Comunanza with analogous instruction because of cholera: The sick cannot return home in an emergency, you remain in the hospital in a designated room. your items will be smoked and disinfected.

... ..and you will despoise an enormous gathering of people who will form the germ of the pestilence and death, since they live closely together like goats and they pollute every quarter with their stink.

The population of animals increases quickly, especially rats which run through the city and the houses in big numbers.
